

PEARL CITY BOARD OF EDUCATION  
Regular Meeting  
February 17, 2021

President Bremmer called the Regular Meeting to order @ 6:30PM.

After Roll Call the Board approved the February 17, 2021 agenda.

The Board recognized guests and public comments were allowed. There were three questions from the January 20<sup>th</sup> meeting that were read by President Bremmer.

Public questions from Mrs. Allseits from January 20<sup>th</sup>:

1. When is the Pearl City School District going to post both the Board Packet and the Board Financials for the meeting to be held on January 20, 2021?
2. Are you ever going to be to the point where these can be posted at the same time as the Agenda for public consumption or are you not capable to doing so; if you are not, why not? The packets have already gone out to the Board Members so why do you withhold them from the public?
3. How can the public be allowed ample time to submit questions to the Board prior to the meeting if they are not yet posted as of this time and date (of January 19th at 2:12 p.m./the time of this email) since the public is under a time constraint (NLT 4 p.m the day of the Board meeting) to submit questions to the District?

The Board approved the Consent Agenda consisting of the minutes from the January 20, 2021 regular board meeting and closed meeting minutes and bills and payroll through Feb. 12th, 2021 for \$411,683.84.

Communications:

Dr. Schiffman shared FOIA request from Mrs. Lisa Allseits:

- Please provide me a copy of the email that I sent to Janis Sheffey (email address of [jsheffey@pcwolves.net](mailto:jsheffey@pcwolves.net)) this past week as questions to be submitted for the Board of Education meeting held on January 20, 2021.
- Please also provide copies of Janis Sheffey's distribution of the email described above and all public records relating to or regarding it. This would include, but not be limited to, emails, notes, text messages, telephone logs relating or regarding to both the email and the requests made therein as well as any decisions made pertaining to why these questions were not to be read during the meeting when as a member of the public my questions were submitted in a timely fashion according to the rules shared by Pearl City School District.

Dr. Schiffman shared the five candidates for the school board elections on April 6<sup>th</sup>. There will be more information about the candidates in the monthly newsletter and on the website.

New Business:

1. The School Board heard the first reading of the 2021-2022 District Calendar.
2. The School Board approved the inter-governmental agreements with Lena-Winslow School District for Boys and Girls Golf and Girls Track for the 2021-2022 and 2022-2023 seasons.
3. The School Board approved the Multi-Year lease of seven new school buses for four years at a price of \$16,514/bus/year.
4. The School Board also approved a resolution for the TRS Supplemental Savings Plan.
5. The School Board approved Dan Rowe and Noel Aponte as Volunteer Softball Coaches.
6. The School Board approved Kristy Fransen as JH Volleyball Coach for the 2021 season.
7. The School Board approved the extension and retaining of Dr. Schiffman as the Pearl City School District Superintendent from July, 2021 through and including June 30, 2025. His base salary will be \$123,600 for the 2021-2022 contract year. This is the same salary as the 2020-2021 school year.
8. The School Board approved a two-year multi-year contract for Mr. Ben Asche as the JH/HS Principal for the Pearl City School District. His base salary will be \$77,765 for the 2021-2022 school year.
9. The School Board approved a 3% increase for Mr. Brent Chrisman, Elementary Principal, and a 3% increase for the Non-Certified staff for the 2021-2022 school year.
